The STAR Framework for Powerful Teaching and Learning is made up of 5 Essential Components, 15 Indicators, and 131 Strategies. The 5 Essential Components and Reference Codes for the 15 Indicators are listed below. Because of the developmental nature of the STAR Framework for Powerful Teaching & Learning all 15 Indicators are inter-related (alpha .92). As such, many, and in some cases most, of the STAR Indicators align with the various evaluation elements. However, we have included the most obvious, and probably the most important, STAR Indicators that align to each of the Model Elements.
